Procedure for {A 8 – Administration of the College



1. The Board of Trustees governs Midway College and has the fiduciary responsibility to oversee its operations and educational programs. The board approves the general mission of the college, appoints and evaluates the president who is the chief executive officer.
2. The President of the college plans, designs and implements the mission of the college as set by the Board of Trustees. The president approves the college procedures to implement the board policies and has final authority in all college matters not vested with the Board of Trustees.
3. The President depends on four internal constituencies, the faculty, administrative staff, staff association and student government association to receive advice and council on matters of college policy and procedure.
