**Kentucky Board of Nursing Policy
on Requirements for
Licensure Applicants with Criminal Convictions**

Policy Adopted: March, 1997

The following section of Kentucky Administrative Regulation 210 KAR 20:370 applies to all those applying for Licensure as a nurse in the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

Section 4. Beginning January 1, 1998 in addition to the requirements imposed by Section 1 of the administrative regulation, an applicant for Licensure by examination or endorsement shall comply with the requirements of the Section.

- (1) An applicant shall not be eligible for the NCLEX examination or Licensure if the applicant has been convicted:
 - (a) of a felony under one of the KRS chapters specified in subsection (2) of this section, within five (5) years of the date of filing an application; or
 - (b) for violation of a comparable law in another jurisdiction.
- (2)
 - (a) KRS Chapter 189A (driving under the influence)
 - (b) KRS Chapter 218A (controlled substances)
 - (c) KRS Chapter 507 (criminal homicide)
 - (d) KRS Chapter 508 (assault and related offenses)
 - (e) KRS Chapter 509 (kidnapping and related offenses)
 - (f) KRS Chapter 510 (sexual offenses)
 - (g) KRS Chapter 511 (burglary and related offenses)
 - (h) KRS Chapter 512 (criminal damage to property)
 - (i) KRS Chapter 513 (arson and related offenses)
 - (j) KRS Chapter 514 (theft and related offenses)
 - (k) KRS Chapter 515 (robbery)
 - (l) KRS Chapter 516 (forgery and related offenses)
 - (m) KRS Chapter 521 (bribery and corrupt offenses)
 - (n) KRS Chapter 523 (perjury and related offenses)
 - (o) KRS Chapter 525 (riot, disorderly conduct and related offenses)
 - (p) KRS Chapter 527 (offenses related to firearms and weapons)
 - (q) KRS Chapter 528 (gambling)
 - (r) KRS Chapter 529 (prostitution offenses)
 - (s) KRS Chapter 531 (pornography) and
 - (t) KRS Chapter 506 (offenses of attempts, conspiracy, or complicity to commit the offenses specified in this section).
- (3)
 - (a) A Notice to Deny Licensure shall be issued to an applicant for Licensure who has been convicted of an offense specified by subsection (2) of this section.
 - (b) An applicant who has been issued a Notice to Deny Licensure may request a hearing before a hearing panel. The request shall be postmarked within thirty (30) days of receipt of the notice.

- (4) (a) An applicant for Licensure by examination or endorsement shall report:
 - 1. Convictions for crimes specified in subsections (1) and (2) of this section for which the applicant was convicted prior to the time periods specified in subsection (1) of this section; and
 - 2. Convictions for crimes that are not specified in subsections (1) and (2) of this section.
- (b) The Board shall review convictions reported pursuant to paragraph (a) of this subsection on an individual basis.

This regulation requires that a notice of intent to deny Licensure be issued to an applicant for Licensure who has a felony conviction within five (5) years of the date of application for Licensure, or a misdemeanor conviction within two (2) years of the date of application for Licensure. **Please note that the Kentucky Administrative Regulation 201 KAR 20:370 was revised as of 12/9/97 to exclude misdemeanor convictions from automatic denial of Licensure. However, all misdemeanor convictions must continue to be reported to the board.**

If an applicant has a criminal conviction older than five (5) years for the felony or two (2) years for the misdemeanor from the date of application for Licensure, or misdemeanor or felony not listed under Section 2, the applicant shall:

- (1) Write a letter to the Executive Director of the Board of Nursing explaining the circumstances of the crime.
- (2) Request that official, certified copy of the charges, conviction, and penalty be sent to the Executive Director of the Kentucky Board of Nursing.
- (3) Subsequently supply additional information as required, either in writing or in person.
